3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Flood Insurance Af-

5 fordability Act".

1SEC. 2. GRACE PERIOD FOR FLOOD INSURANCE COV-2ERAGE.

3 PAY-(a) SUSPEND PREMIUM AUTHORITY TO MENTS.—During the period that begins on the date of en-4 5 actment of this Act and ends 30 days after the date on which the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Man-6 7 agement Agency first makes available to policyholders of 8 flood insurance coverage under the national flood insur-9 ance program a monthly premium payment option for 10 flood insurance coverage in compliance with section 11 1308(g) of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42) 12 U.S.C. 4015(g)), any new and existing policyholders to which such section 1308(g) applies shall remain covered 13 under such a flood insurance policy notwithstanding the 14 nonpayment of premiums to cover that period. 15

16 Premium (b) Recoupment UNPAID OF 17 AMOUNTS.—The Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency shall provide that, after the expira-18 tion of the period referred to in subsection (a), there shall 19 20 be assessed on each policyholder who elects to pay flood insurance coverage premiums on a monthly basis pursuant 21 22 to section 1308(g) of the National Flood Insurance Act 23 of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4015(g)) an extra monthly fee in an 24 amount calculated by the Administrator to recover, on a 25 cumulative basis, the amount of premiums unpaid pursuant to subsection (a). 26

(c) OTHER GRACE PERIODS.—The grace period
under subsection (a) for nonpayment of premiums shall
be in addition to any other grace period provided for under
a policy for flood insurance coverage under the national
flood insurance program.

6 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON FEES ASSOCIATED WITH MONTH7 LY PAYMENTS.

8 Section 1308(g) of the National Flood Insurance Act 9 of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4015(g)) is amended by striking "an-10 nually or monthly." and inserting "annually or monthly, 11 and may not apply any fee or additional charge with re-12 spect to a policyholder who chooses to make monthly pay-13 ments compared to a policyholder who chooses to make 14 payments annually.".
