**A BILL**

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to purchase at-home tests for SARS-CoV-2 from certain foreign entities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxpayer Dollars  
5 for Communist China COVID Tests Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USING FEDERAL FUNDS TO PUR-**  
7 **CHASE CERTAIN TESTS.**

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-  
9 eral funds may be used to purchase any at-home test for  
10 SARS-CoV-2 that is—

- 1           (1) manufactured, in whole or in part, in the
- 2           People's Republic of China;
- 3           (2) imported from the People's Republic of
- 4           China; or
- 5           (3) manufactured by any entity that is a sub-
- 6           sidiary of a Chinese company.
